# A New Service Model in Gateshead

From 1<sup>st</sup> November 2018 CGL will be providing the Integrated Drug and Alcohol services for adults in Gateshead in partnership with GP Federation and Recovery Connections .

Cgl will be the lead provider of services in Gateshead, working in partnership with Recovery Connections who will deliver a widerange of activities and programmes to help support clients through their recovery. Clients will be offered groups, programmes and services including Quasi Rehabilitation.

The GP Federation are a small group of local GP's who will provide specialist prescribing treatment to those clients registered within their surgery. There are 6 GP's surgeries within the Federation; Oxford Terrace, Bensham Family Practice, Teams Surgery, Central Medical Group, Birtley Medical Group and Whickham Surgery.

Over the next few months CGL's Implementation Team will be working with Council, stakeholders, commissioners and yourselves to ensure that the needs of Gateshead residents affected by drug & alcohol misuse are improved, building on established links already in place.
